

Type 2 diabetes mellitus accounts for 90–95 % of all diabetes cases. According to International Diabetes Foundation, by 2040, the worlwide number of adults with diabetes is projected to increase to 642 million, and countries in the developing economies contribute disproportionately to the escalating global diabetes burden. Among the different interventions of proven efficacy in preventing diabetes, beside good glycemic control, lifestyle modification is the most appealing because of its high efficacy, reduced costs and beneficial effects in various ethnic groups.

- In the South part of Friuli Venezia Giulia, 32 Municipalities, 120.000 inhabitants, are asked to provide in every Municipality a free room adeguately equipped and accessible to diasbled person;
- Recruit and train volunteers from the "Bassa Friulana Diabetic Family Association ODV" to be engaged 4-6 hours/week on diabetic counselling for diabetic citizens, family members and caregivers, directly in the area of residence;
- Guarantee assistance, support and information regarding diabetes and related diseases

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- allow citizens to be able to directly, simply and continuously benefit from a FREE HEALTH INFORMATION SERVICE within their municipality of residence;
- reduce the risk to develop Diabetes Mellitus in predisposed patients;
- reduced the risk in a diabetic patient, to develop serious, even disabling complications related to Diabetes over the years.





Diabetic and related diseases **screening**:

- weight, height, BMI
- blood pressure measurement
- blood glucose test
- blood cholesterol test
- peripheral oxygen saturation
- smoking attitude





Diabetic and related diseases counselling:

- weight control
- low carbohydrate and low-calorie diet
- physical activity
- quit smoking advice
- referral to Family Doctor
- referral to Outpatient Diabetic Clinic





The effective translation of diabetes prevention across global communities requires engagement and coordination at multiple levels within health-care services, civic society, government agencies.

The establishment of Community Diabetes Prevention Centers, to serve as hub for harmonizing the planning, delivery, and evaluation of lifestyle intervention activities, would be an efficient approach to global diabetes prevention.
